

Registration instructions for the education edition of ArcGIS software

To register and download your personal ArcGIS software license you can use the link below. This ArcGIS software has full functionality and a one-year license for educational purpose only.

1. Go to www.esri.com/educationedition and login with your Esri Global account. If you do not have created a free account yet (you need it for the Tutorials as well), first do so and then login.
2. Enter the authorization (EVA) code you have received and click 'Activate ArcGIS'.
3. Select version 'ArcGIS 10.6.1 for Desktop' (or latest version) and/or ArcGIS pro (if needed) to download. You will now receive an email from ESRI with instructions. Simultaneously, you will be redirected to a next webpage with instructions and download links.
4. Download at least 'ArcGIS for Desktop' (about 950 Mb). Check which other optional extensions you want to install (at least data interoperability) . For standard users, none of these are required. If your computer does not yet have Microsoft .Net Framework 3.5 SP1 installed, please also download this package. If you do not know whether your computer already has this software installed, download it anyway. Upon installation (see next step), your computer will most likely tell you whether it is already installed or not.
5. Install the Microsoft .Net Framework 3.5 Service Pack 1 if required.
6. Install 'ArcGIS for Desktop', and subsequently also the optional extension(s) you may have downloaded.
7. Authorize the installed software by opening the ArcGIS Administrator tool (All Programs -> ArcGIS). Select Desktop -> Advanced ArcInfo Single Use and click Authorize Now. Then select the option 'I have installed my software and need to authorize it' and subsequently 'Authorize using internet'. Fill in all personal details as required, indicating that you use this for educational purposes and finally provide your authorization (EVA) code. You can accept the default option 'I do not wish to authorize any extensions at this time' as the standard extensions will be authorized automatically.
